

# Hay Burners Equine “Small Tub Topper” installation instructions

## What’s Included:

- “Tub Topper” slow feed net with elastic cord
- Cable Ties (8) \*Fastening option 1
- Tie Cords (8) \*Fastening option 2
- Buckle Strap assemblies (3)

## What’s Required:

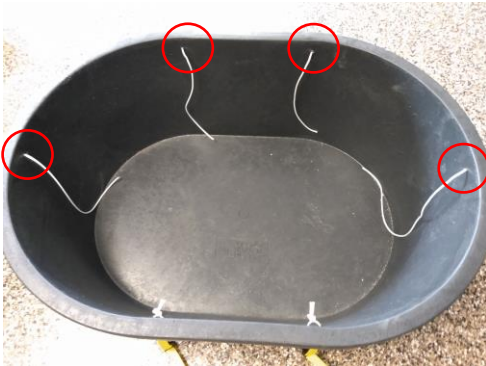
- 40 gallon water tub.

## Suggested tools (not provided):

- Power drill and 5/16 drill bit
- Marker or Pencil
- Measuring tape or ruler
- Side Cutters (optional)

## Step 1 – Drill attachment holes

- Using 5/16” or slightly larger drill bit, drill holes just under lip of tub. Space approximately as shown by the red circles. Ties are put through the holes to help show location .



## Step 2 (Front of Tub)

- Drill 4 holes (2 sets of 2) approximately as shown.
- Space the holes roughly 1” apart . These are for the attachment of the buckle straps



## Step 3 (Front of Tub)

- Using a zip ties or tie cords provided fasten the Buckle Strap to the tub through the holes created in Step 2.



#### **Step 4 (Ends and back of Tub)**

- Using either the cable ties or tie cords provided (depending on preference) Feed the desired fastening method through the holes in the tub at 4 locations. Two at each of the rounded ends position and the other at the center back position. (show with the string through the hole for clarity)



#### **Step 5**

- Using the Cable Ties or optionally, the Tie Cords, fasten the net capturing the net material and elastic cord. It is recommended to start at one of the rounded end positions then the center back position and finally the other rounded end position. Tuck the elastic up under the lip and secure with strings/zip ties
- When using the Cable Ties snip off the remaining end extending from the clinching feature of the tie using the side cutters.



#### **Step 6**

- Grab the net at the elastic cord and pull it over the front of the tub to complete the installation.
- Feed the Buckle Straps around the net and elastic cord and snap the buckles together to secure the net.
- To fill the tub simply unclasp the buckle straps, grab the net near the lip of the tub at the front and pull out and up to manage the elastic cord over the lip of the tub.
- Flip the loose net material over the back of the tub to open an area large enough to place a bale into the tub.
